Show and contest rules - Attire #2	The exhibitor in a classics or games classes, must be neatly dressed in suitable western attire. This includes western hat, belt, boots, western pants or jeans, and western type or a collared dress shirt. The use of pins with stand up collars is optional in classic events, and ties are optional for games events. A belt is optional in all Games and Reining Events.	Add to the end: An exhibitor may enter gaming classes in serviceable English tack and according attire (ie, breeches, polo shirt, helmet, boots, belt), however their runs will count as an exhibition only and will not collect points. Show and contest rules - Equipment #4	In any class, horses 5 years and under may be shown either with a bit, hackamore bosal, or snaffle bit. A horse shown with a bosal or snaffle bit may be ridden with 2 hands on the reins. Reins may or may not be crossed. AQHA rules will apply with determining the legality of snaffle bits and bosals.	In any class, horses of any age may be shown either with a shanked bit, hackamore bosal or a snaffle bit. A horse shown with a bosal or snaffle bit may be ridden with 2 hands on the reins. A horse ridden in a shanked bit must be ridden with only 1 hand. Reins may or may not be crossed. AQHA rules will apply with determining the legality of snaffle bits and bosals. Preference given to horse/rider combo respecting original rules at judge's discretion.	Approved.
Youth rules; eligibility #2	A youth may not show a pony in a youth event where horses would be in the ring at the same time. For example, Showmanship at Halter, Equitation, and Pleasure	To add: youth/teen classes and or youth/adult classes may be combined to be in the ring at one time, but judged separately if entries for both classes combined are under 6 horses. Class requirements #7	A show must have an adult walk/jog class. Riders in adult walk/jog cannot show in any other riding class.	A show must have a walk/jog class. Riders showing in walk/jog cannot show in any other riding class with the exception of walk/jog trail.	*no vote needed
